

Borth – WSRA North League Race Day Sunday 6th August 2017

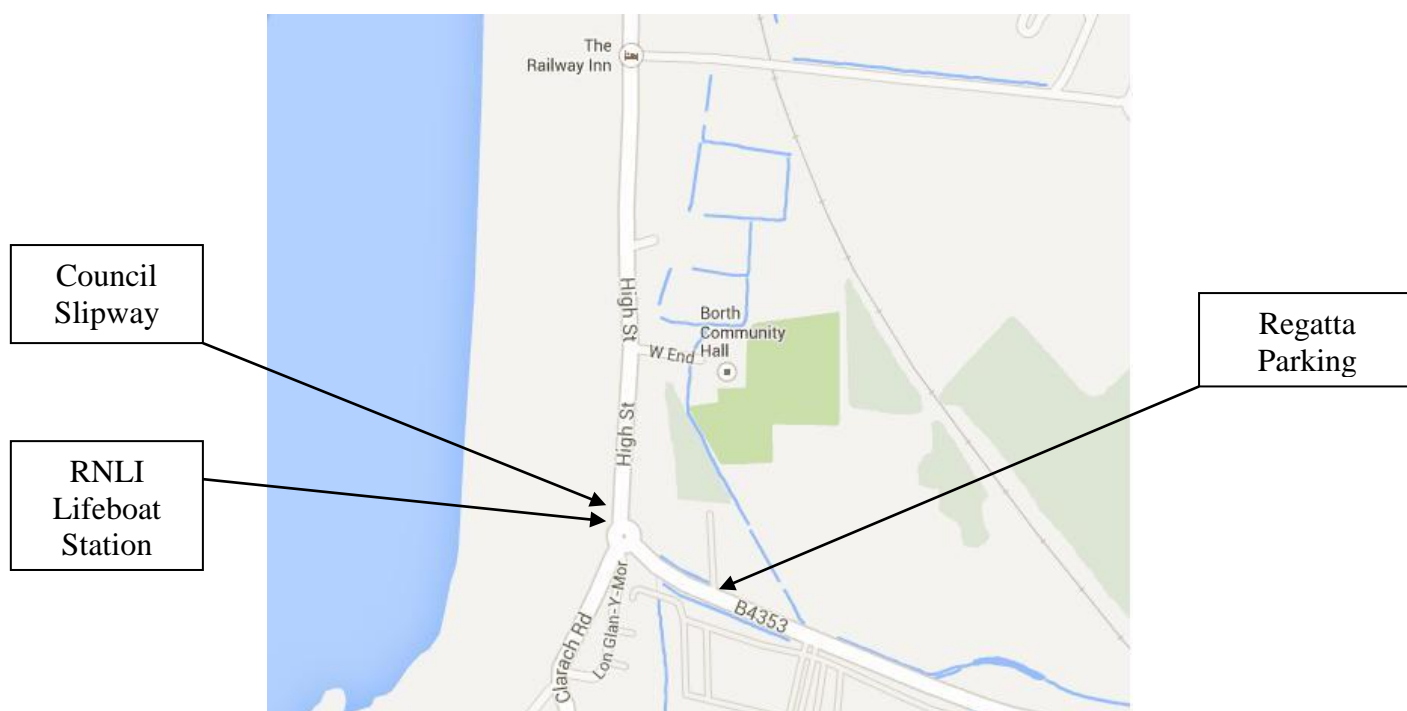
- Registration: 10.00am – 12 noon on Borth Beach front, beside RNLI Station.
- Coxes Briefing: 12:15pm – on Borth Beach front, beside RNLI Station.
- First Race: 12:30pm – prompt, due to tidal constraints.

The race will follow a buoyed course along the sea front at Borth, SY24 5LJ, to Ynyslas, allowing spectator viewing of the whole course from the sea wall.

Race Order: 1) Ladies, 2) Seniors, 3) Juniors/Novices, 4) Mixed

Race Fees: £5 Adults / £2.00 Juniors

If you are travelling from the **South** SatNav may send you along a narrow country road unsuitable for trailers after Aberystwyth, so if you are towing we advise you travel via '**Bow Street**' and then along the **B4353**.

From the **North**, turn right at **Tre'r-ddol** and pass through Ynyslas and through the golf course and then come all the way through Borth as far as the RNLI lifeboat station.

On arrival, and before the mini roundabout in the centre of Borth, Boat Trailers should pull over on the road and wait for instructions from the Marshals. Boats will be unloaded on the beach and towing vehicles will need to drive down the **slipway** next to the **RNLI station**. The slipway can only take one vehicle at a time, so Marshals will be on-hand to direct traffic. Boats should be unloaded quickly and left on the beach, away from the RNLI slipway. The vehicle and trailer should then proceed to the regatta parking area.

Competitors should then return to the Borth Beach front, beside RNLI Station for registration. Refreshments will be available all day. Public toilets are available nearby. After all races are complete food will be served.
